- Two unedited photographs of the artwork should be submitted in [jpeg/jpg](#) format. One image will be of the original artwork and the second one will be of the child holding/ standing with the artwork. The face of the participant should be clearly visible. Clarity of images with proper light to be given preference while clicking photographs.
- Students from group "A" and "B", can use any medium or technique to show their creativity.
- Only one submission will be taken from each student.
- Any kind of digital work will not be encouraged.
- The artworks will be judged based on the following pointers:
  - 1) **Uniqueness**
  - 2) **Aesthetic quality**
  - 3) **Neatness**
  - 4) **Overall presentation**
- The artwork should be original work of the candidate, otherwise the entry may be cancelled without any further information.
- Each group will have a first, second and third position. There will be Special Recognition certificate for each group's star performer(s).
- All the participants will be issued a digital certificate. The winning images will be displayed on school's website and also will be shared with all the parents over live online event/newsletter.
- All the original artwork (Hard copy) should be kept carefully by the participants. Since, they will get an opportunity to display those in the school after reopening.

- Song should be on karaoke or download app (Tanpura, Percussion etc.)
- It should be video not audio (Face should be clearly visible)
- Group A and B may select any song from the provided list.
- Performance should be in costume/ School Uniform.
- The song sung should be original work of the participant with no editing and should be one take recording, otherwise the entry may be cancelled without any further information.
- Judgment will be based on the following attributes:
  - Tal
  - Swara
  - Expression
  - Overall presentation
- Each group will have a first, second and third position. There will be Special Recognition certificate for each group's star performer(s).
- All the participants will be issued a digital certificate. The links of winning songs will be displayed on school's website and also will be shared with all the parents over live online event/newsletter.
- The winners will be given opportunity to sing, the same song live on stage when the school reopens.

OR

Any pure Classical dance form with Indian Classical instrumental music.

## Rules and Regulations:

- Only one entry allowed per participant.

- Movement and facial expression should be clear and prominently visible.
- Sound quality should be good and clear.
- Dance has to be with proper makeup and appropriate costume.
- Pure classical dance performer must use Ghungroo and dress up with appropriate dance form.
- Duration of Video:
  - Group A Video should not be more than 3 minutes.
  - Group B and Group C: Video should not be more than 4 minutes.
- The costume should be decent and presentable.
- Film songs or popular album songs are strictly prohibited.
- The dance performed should be original work of the participant with no editing and should be one take recording from single location, otherwise the entry may be cancelled without any further information.
- Judgment will be based on the following attributes:
  - Body movements
  - Expression
  - Rhythm
  - Overall Presentation
- Each group will have a first, second and third position. There will be Special Recognition certificate for each group's star performer(s).
- The link of winning performances will be displayed on school's website and also will be shared with all the parents over live online event/newsletter.
- The winners will be given opportunity to perform, the same dance live on stage when the school reopens.
